- 2. The competition is open to Kullilli people of all ages.
- 3. All entrants must:
 - · Be of Kullilli descent:
 - · Not be a current employee of the Kullilli Bulloo River Aboriginal Corporation.
- 4. Entrants under the age of 18 years must have the permission of a parent or guardian to enter. The parent or guardian must agree to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the artist.
- 5. The artwork must be the artist's original work and must not breach any copyright or third-party rights.
- 6. The artists must submit a written story about the artwork.
 - The artwork must be submitted in a two-dimensional format. The following mediums will be accepted:
 - · Paint: acrylic, gouache, ink, oils, enamel, watercolour, tempera, poster paint, ochre.
 - · Drawing: graphite, colour pencils, textas, markers, charcoal, ink, chalk, conte crayons, pastels
 - · Natural materials: soil, mud, vegetation, coffee, sand, plants.
 - · Original digital illustration (submitted on a USB or email, in high-resolution PDF, jpg or png file format)
- 8. The artwork must be appropriate for reproduction, exhibition and publishing. Artists should consider this to ensure there are no cultural or religious impediments to prevent reproduction.
- 9. The copyright of the chosen artwork will remain property of the winning artist.
- 10. The artist agrees that the Kullilli Bulloo River Aboriginal Corporation may photograph and reproduce their artwork entry for the purposes of the People's Choice Voting System.
- 11. The artist agrees that the Kullilli Bulloo River Aboriginal Corporation may reproduce the winning artwork for the purposes of the shirt design and production, publicity and promotion. This includes the story behind the artwork. The artist will be appropriately attributed in all reproductions.
- 12. The Kullilli Bulloo River Aboriginal Corporation does not accept responsibility for any lost, late or misdirected entries.
- 13. The winner will be selected by a 'People's Choice' public vote. The decision is final. No correspondence about the decision will be entered into
